Nature of support 2014/2015

The funding received from Pupil Premium has been allocated in the following ways -

- Continued support from additional Teaching Assistant to provide support across the school enabling teachers and intervention support staff to target individuals and groups more effectively.
- Additional teaching staff for part of the week.
- Additional Educational Psychologist (E.P.) time from E.P. service.
- Transport costs for identified pupil/pupils to attend 'off site' support/therapies.
- Services of peripatetic professionals to work with identified cohorts, groups and individual children on focused intervention/support.
- Screening programmes to ensure 'early identification' of need.
- Continued support from ICT consultant.
- To subsidise some Breakfast Club and After School places.
