Nature of support 2015/16

The funding received from Pupil Premium has been allocated in the following ways -

- Contribution towards recruitment of a 'Learning Mentor'
- Continued support from additional Teaching Assistants to provide support across the school, enabling teachers and intervention support staff to target individuals and groups more effectively.
- 1:1 support for individual child (daily A.M)
- Additional teaching staff for part of the week.
- Additional Educational Psychologist (E.P.) time from E.P. service (via Consortia)
- Screening programmes to ensure 'early identification' of need.
- Continued support from ICT consultant.
- Subsidising Breakfast Club and After School places.
- Payment for extra-curricular clubs/activities
- Payment for school uniforms
