#### Nature of support 2013/2014

The funding received from Pupil Premium has been allocated in the following ways -

- Continued input from Teaching Assistants to provide support across the school enabling teachers and intervention support staff to target individuals and groups more effectively.
- Leasing of school minibus which will allow children more frequent access to cultural and heritage sites, museums and art galleries and places of local interest.
- Engaging the services of educational professionals to support the school in further development of assessment procedures to enable earliest identification of need for the most vulnerable children.
- To provide additional services from educational creative partners to extend and enrich children's experiences.
- To engage the services of ICT curriculum consultant on a weekly basis.
- The purchase of ICT equipment to replace and update current provision across the school.
- To update and enhance Key Stage 1 outdoor provision.
- To subsidise some Breakfast Club and After School places.

#### Measuring the impact of PPG spending
