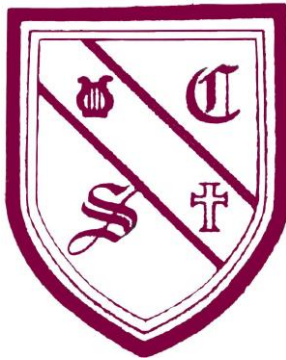

Your children can make a good start.

Read below what is the expected uniform for the junior school.

Boys

Maroon jumpers
White shirt
Maroon/grey tie
Grey / Black Trousers
Black Shoes

Girls

Maroon cardigans or jumper
White shirt
Maroon/grey tie
Grey Skirt / black tailored trousers
Black Shoes

Additionally, children are expected to carry their water bottle, homework, reading book and reading record to and from school, every day, in a school book bag (available from Unit Form on Muirhead Avenue, or Laser Schoolwear on West Derby Road), check local opening times.

Children should bring in their PE kit in a school gym bag (available from Unit Form or Laser Schoolwear for approximately £3) or other small gym bag on a Monday morning and they will be expected to leave their PE kit in school until Thursday.

Children are provided with the necessary stationary they need to complete their lessons.

No children should bring in their own stationary or pencil cases.
